Workshop Meeting

The Yarmouth Conservation Commission will meet in a workshop format to propose and discuss changes to the regulations promulgated by the Town of Yarmouth Conservation Commission pursuant to the authority granted to it under Chapter 143, Section 2, D of the Town of Yarmouth Wetland By-law.

Information on the proposed changes is available at the Yarmouth Conservation Office, Yarmouth Town Offices, during regular business hours 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Written comments will be accepted and should be directed to the Conservation Commission at the Yarmouth Town Offices. Public input will be accepted at the discretion of the chairman.

The meeting will be held by remote participation pursuant to Massachusetts Governor Charles D. Baker's Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law dated March 12, 2020. No in-person attendance of members of the public will be permitted, but every effort will be made to ensure that the public can adequately access the proceedings in real time, via technological means. In the event that we are unable to do so, despite best efforts, we will post on the town's website an audio or video recording, transcript, or other comprehensive record of proceedings as soon as possible after the meeting.
