No in-person attendance of members of the public will be permitted, but every effort will be made to ensure that the public can adequately access the proceedings in real time, via technological means. In the event that we are unable to do so, despite best efforts, we will post on the town's website an audio or video recording, transcript, or other comprehensive record of proceedings as soon as possible after the meeting.

- Applicants attending by dial-in should press \*9 to notify the chair of their presence when called upon. The meeting host will un-mute applicants when they are called upon to speak.
- Online audience members wishing to participate during the public comment section of a hearing can use the "Raise Hand" button to notify the chair. All participants will be muted, you must be recognized by the chair to participate.
- Dial-in audience members wishing to participate during the public comment section of a hearing should press \*9 on their phone to notify the chair. All participants will be muted, you must be recognized by the chair to participate.
