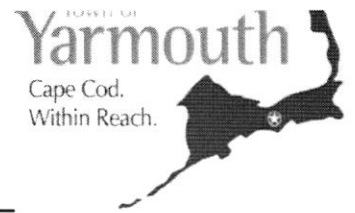

## MINUTES OF BOARD OF ASSESSORS' MEETING

**February 15, 2018**

Chairman Joe Sullivan called the meeting to order at 10:10am. In attendance were Board members Stephanie Miller and Jay Serijan, Director of Assessing, Andy Machado and Tara Monroe, Assessor's Office Department Assistant.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** None.

**DIRECTOR UPDATE:** There are two proposed Town Meeting articles to discuss.

- 1.) MGL Chapter 60, Section 3D allows city or town aid to elderly and disabled taxation fund; voluntary check off donations

This article will allow Town of Yarmouth to place a voluntary check off box on its mailed out tax bills whereby the taxpayers may voluntarily check off, donate and pledge an amount not less than \$1.00 and to establish a city or town aid to the elderly and disabled taxation fund for the purpose of defraying the real estate taxes of elderly and disabled persons of low income. A taxation aid committee will be established and consist of the chairman of the Board of Assessors, the city or town treasurer and three residents of the city or town to be appointed by the Board of Selectmen.


- 2.) To see if the Town will vote to accept the provisions of MGL Chapter 59, Section 5, Clause 54 relative to the exemption of personal property with an assessed value of \$10,000 or less from taxation, or to take any other action relating thereto. The Board voted unanimously to move forward in the process with these two articles.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Chairman Joe Sullivan made a motion to accept the minutes of the December 21, 2017 meeting. Board member Jay Serijan seconded the motion. Vote to approve the minutes was unanimous. Members reviewed and signed monthly reports. All members authorized the Assessor's office to stamp all statutory exemption applications, abatement applications and denial notices.

The meeting adjourned at 11:05 AM.

The next meeting is scheduled for **March 1, 2018 at 10:00 AM** in Hearing Room A.
