Meeting of the Recreation Commission

September 09, 2020

- In attendance: Deb Clark, Dennis Lucier, Dorcas McGurrin, Paul Deignan, Steve Sozanski, Josh Medeiros, Chris Hartsgrove, Asst Director Howell
- Public: none
- Commissioner McGurrin called the meeting to order @ 6:00PM
- The MGL regarding open meeting via tele-conference were read
- Chris Hartsgrove appointed to the Recreation Commission
- Steve will transcribe notes of 08/12/20 meeting into minutes format
- Acting Director Howell reported:
 - No basketball program this fall due to lack of gym space
 - Possible Flax daycare if schools use remote learning
 - 15 children max-possibly funding Ruth Nee's salary?
 - Pending Seasonal Search permission from MA state Labor
 - Flax Pond summer program was a success-gross of \$25K
 - Reduced income due to attendance reduction from norm of 300 to 100 attendees
 - Income insufficient to fund Ruth Nee's salary
 - Additional funding is being sourced
 - Sailing program net of \$11K
 - Budget cut of \$25K request for upcoming year
 - Halloween event w/Chamber of Commerce on 10/31/20-movie
 - Fall programs-Tai Chi, Karate, tennis, Kinder soccer, Basketball skills+Drills
 - No swimming due to Covid 19 restrictions
 - Pickleball ends at the end of October-possibly through to November
 - Revenue of \$4K received
 - Possibility of extended season at additional charge to players?
- Commissioner Lucier asked about the ability to CORI under 18 year olds
 - Acting Director Howell to investigate
