**POLICY TITLE: High Pressure Sodium Streetlight Installation**

**POLICY CODE AND NUMBER: 03-04**

**DATE: July 29, 2003**

Upon request, the Board of Selectmen may authorize installation of streetlights insofar as the placement of the streetlight conforms with at least one of the following conditions:

- A. Intersection of Streets
- B. Along curves in the road
- C. At locations where there are inclines or declines in roads which would cause safety problems
- D. At locations where the safety of the public would be improved by the installation of a light

Streetlights shall not be installed on straight roads where the only purpose to installing a light would be to light a particular house or location.

The Board of Selectmen assumes no responsibility whatsoever for determining which locations within the Town should have streetlights. This policy statement is meant only as a guide to inform the general public of circumstances in which the Board of Selectmen will authorize the placement of streetlights, and should in no way be considered as any type of directive requiring streetlight to be placed at particular locations in the Town of Yarmouth.
