

The Town of Yarmouth Recycles!

Cardboard:



Cardboard should be flattened and placed in the cardboard container.



Please do not put pizza boxes in the cardboard container. Even if it looks clean, a small amount of grease can contaminate the cardboard that surrounds it.



Mixed Paper:



Clean paper products, such as junk mail, newsprint, office paper, chip board (cereal boxes), etc. should be placed in the mixed paper container.



Please do not put used paper goods in the mixed paper container. Examples of these items are used napkins, tissues, or paper plates.



Comingle:



Comingle recyclables include all glass, metals, and plastics (#1 - #7). See the reverse for examples.



Magazines & Catalogs:



Magazines can be reused in the magazine swap shed, before they are recycled. Magazines (that are no longer usable) and catalogs can be placed in the magazine container. This container is located adjacent to the magazine shed.



For your protection, cut out, peel off, or mark out your name and address. Also, remove any catalog order forms. These can then be recycled in the mixed paper container.

Yarmouth also recycles a variety of other items.

To recycle used motor oil, anti-freeze, batteries (auto, button, and rechargeable), and all mercury bearing items (thermometers, thermostats, fluorescent bulbs, etc.) please see the gate attendant. There are also many donation containers for clothing and 5¢ returnable bottles and cans.
