

COMMINGLED	METAL 	* Steel, tin & metal food cans * Aluminum pie plates & trays * Deposit & no-deposit drink cans	* Rinse trays clean * Labels are OK * Rinse cans clean	NOTE: All metal should be recycled, but some metal can be placed in the SMALL METAL CAN.
	PLASTIC 	* Milk, water, soda & juice bottles * Shampoo & conditioner bottles * Laundry, bleach & softener bottles	* Rinse plastic clean * Caps are OK	* Styrofoam packaging and "peanuts" * Motor oil & chemical containers * Water/garden hose * Black plastic carry out containers * Nips * Plastic cup lids * Straws * Flower pots * Cartons with wax * Laundry baskets * Colored plastic cups
	GLASS 	* Clear & colored beverage bottles * Food & sauce jars	* Rinse glass clean * Caps/lids are OK * Neck rings/labels are OK	* Drinking glass * Auto glass * Mirrors & windows * Ceramic plates & cookware * Light bulbs
COMPACTOR	OCC 	* OCC = OLD CORROGATED CARDBOARD * All clean corrugated cardboard must be recycled	* Flatten, fold, or break down corrugated cardboard	* Food-soiled cardboard * Contaminated boxes * Cereal, tissue boxes (see mixed paper)
	NEWSPAPER 	* NEWSPAPERS ONLY	* Please place newspaper and any newspaper advertisements in the NEWSPAPER container	* All non-newspaper and other items included with newspaper are MIXED PAPER
	MIXED PAPER 	* MIXED PAPER is all non newspaper items, including cereal, tissue, and non corrugated boxes, office paper, envelopes, brown paper bags etc.	* See list below for items that can be placed in the Mixed Paper container	* No paper items that are wet or contaminated by food can be placed in the Mixed Paper container * Used napkins, towels, tissues, plates, cups * Wax paper * Cartons with wax coating * Paper take out containers SEE LIST ON THE OTHER SIDE OF THIS PAGE
METAL	SCRAP METAL 	* Scrap metal container is available for those with a sticker, to deposit metal items that will fit within the openings	* Scrap metal includes steel, iron, lead, aluminium, copper, stainless steel and zinc.	* No fire extinguishers * No propane tanks. (See Scale) * No light bulbs. * No metal gas cans.

RECYCLING NOTES

1. PLEASE DO NOT put shredded paper in recycle bin. (JAMS THE MACHINES)
2. Deposit bottles can be donated at the Charitable Redemption Center shed.
3. If unsure where to place an item, feel free to ask a friendly Gate attendant or Recycler.
4. **PLASTIC BAGS ARE NOT RECYCLABLE** at the Disposal Area, please returned to supermarkets.

Mat board: used in picture framing	PROPANE TANK	Fluorescent tubes & bulbs
Math paper, graph and ledger, etc.	See Scale Attendant \$	Mercury-bearing items & batteries

Packing paper	See Scale Attendant \$	Books in Discovery Book bin
Paper: lined and white	ALL LARGE METAL	COMPOST AT HOME
Paper: fax	See Scale Attendant \$	Fruit peelings and cores
Paper bags: brown and white	TIRES	Vegatable peelings
Paper bags with handles	See Scale Attendant \$	Eggshells
Paper towel and toilet paper TUBES	BRUSH	Coffee grinds
