### SOFT SHELL CLAMS AND QUAHOGS

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** Wednesday, March 1, 2017

**TIME:** Sunrise to Sunset

**SHELLFISHING PERMITTED:** CCB-27 Grays Beach, Chase Garden Creek-

Quahogs, Softshell Clams & Sea Clams **Wednesdays Only**

**OPEN AREA:** Grays Beach east of a line drawn from the west tip of Chapin Memorial Beach in a southerly direction to the east tip of Grays Beach including Clay's Creek east to a line drawn across Chase Garden Creek at the windmill house.

Grays Beach is open Wednesdays Only.

**SC-28 Mill Creek is also open under a previous regulation dated Wednesday, November 2, 2016.**

**Mill Creek is open Sundays & Wednesdays and will close on Sunday, 4/30/2017**

**CLOSED AREAS** Wilbur Park, Lewis Pond, Crowell Road, Springer Lane, and all other areas not listed as open are closed.

**LIMIT:** One (1) level Ten Quart Wire Basket (10 QT.) of Soft Shell Clams, One (1) level Ten Quart Wire Basket (10 QT.) of Quahogs per permit per week and 1/2 Bushel of Sea Clams per day

**SIZE:** No Soft Shell Clams measuring less than two inches (2") at the longest diameter, No Quahog measuring less than one inch (1") across the hinge and No Sea Clam measuring less than five inches (5") in the longest diameter and may be taken.

Shellfish gauges are required.

This Amendment supersedes all other Recreational Quahog and Soft Shell Clam Regulation Amendments.
