Yarmouth Beach Access Plan

The Town of Yarmouth has developed an initial plan for the 2020 beach season consistent with State guidance from the Executive Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs (EOEA) <u>Beach Guidelines for Mangers</u> issued on May 18, 2020.

The Town of Yarmouth will resume charging for Beach Parking beginning May 23, 2020, on weekends, and seven days a week beginning on June 13th. Lifeguards will be present at the beaches seven days a week beginning on June 13th.

The Town is encouraging all residents and taxpayers to purchase beach stickers by mail to limit COVID-19 exposure for employees and the community at large. Completed forms can also be mailed or dropped off at the Town Hall main entrance drop box.

Beach visitors are required to maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet or more at all times, and organized ball games will not be allowed including, but not limited to, volleyball, Kan Jam, spikeball, football, soccer, Kadima, and bocce. Groups larger than 10 people will not be allowed. Beach users must abide by social distancing standards for bathroom lines and follow established visual guidelines for maintaining a 6' distance in all restroom facilities. The restroom facilities will be cleaned at least once daily by staff and perform deep cleaning and disinfection services at least once per week and will follow the EEA COVID-19 Outdoor Recreation Facility Restroom Cleaning Best Practices. Indoor showers and water fountains will also remain closed. Restrooms at the beaches will be open to the public from 8 AM to 4 PM.

Initially there will be three Electronic Message Boards programed to display messages for beach visitors. The locations are Bass River Beach, Seagull Beach, and Bass Hole.

The Town respectfully requests that visitors make sure that all trash is properly disposed of in trash barrels. Please be patient and kind as we all work through this together.
