Dear Yarmouth Business Community:

During this unprecedented time, the Town has been working hard to keep our residents and businesses safe. We understand and share your frustration regarding the uncertainty businesses have faced in terms of re-opening regulations. Now that the State has released their [re-opening report](#), we would like to share re-opening guidance with our business community.

Please refer to the State's [guidance on specific business sectors](#) to find out when your business is allowed to re-open. All businesses must meet the **self-certification** requirement to re-open. This requirement includes drafting a [COVID-19 control plan template](#), posting a [compliance attestation poster](#), and posting [employer](#) and [worker](#) posters. The Yarmouth Board of Health and Department of Labor Standards have [joint enforcement authority](#) for this requirement, but will only initiate enforcement if a complaint is received.

Please know we are in frequent communication with the Chamber of Commerce and businesses that have been directly impacted by COVID-19. I know that things have been difficult and that the recovery process will present extraordinary challenges. We will continue to work with you and our [legislative delegation](#) to get through these challenges together.
