Is My Paint **HAZARDOUS**?

If you see any of these words on the label, it's Hazardous!

Combustible, Oil, Alkyd, Petroleum Distillates, Mineral Spirits, Linseed Oil, Hydrocarbons, Solvent-based, Lacquer, Thinner, Lead, Chromium, Two-part paint, Car or Boat paint, Swimming Pool paint.

Full or partially full cans should be taken to your household hazardous waste collection. For collection schedules visit www.loveyourlocalwater.org

Get **CREATIVE**!

There are many ways to donate or pass-on your unused paint:

- Ask your friends, family, neighbors if they want your paint.
- Give to hobby groups. Beekeepers and boatbuilders use paint for projects.
- Paint is expensive and can be considered a luxury item for some, so donate!
- Community groups such as drama clubs, Scouts, and shelters have big ideas but small budgets. Consider donating your unused paint for their activities.
- Visit your town's paint shed, May through October.
