Free Insulation and Weatherization

Get a free energy assessment, insulation, air sealing, upgraded lighting and possibly a new refrigerator if your income is below 60% of State Median Income

- For renters and homeowners in homes with 1-4 units
- Those with fuel assistance or a discount electric rate automatically qualify

Discount Electric Rate (R-2)

You may be eligible for a reduced electric rate if you qualify for programs including:

- Low Income Energy Assistance (LIHEAP)
- Free and Reduced School or Breakfast
- MassHealth Basic and Standard
- WIC
- Food Stamps
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Mass Veterans Benefits

Mass Solar Loan Program

Generate electricity for your home by securing a low interest loan to install a solar electric system

- Up to 30% reduction in loan amount if your income is below 80% of SMI*
- Interest rate reduced by 1.5% if your income is below 80% of SMI*
- Work with a participating local MA bank or credit union to secure a loan for residential solar installation
