

**TOWN OF YARMOUTH
DISPOSAL AREA REGULATIONS**

Continued in effect, the Town Disposal Area will be open from 7:30 A.M. to 3:30 P.M., Sunday through Saturday. The Disposal Area shall be open daily with the exception of New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Day, President's Day, Patriots Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day when it shall be closed.

SECTION I – STICKER REGULATIONS

All legal residents in the Town of Yarmouth may purchase a Disposal Area sticker at a fee of \$162.00, for the first sticker per household. Second sticker per household shall have a fee of \$81.00. Non-residential, Non-commercial stickers shall have a fee of \$192.00. Stickers may be purchased at the Clerk's Office in the Town Offices, Monday through Friday. Stickers when purchased by mail or on line shall receive a discount of \$5.00 Said sticker will expire March 31st of each year. The fee to replace any sticker shall be \$5.00. The ten trip coupon book shall have a fee of \$100.00, and have a limit of five bags per coupon; each additional bag shall have a fee of \$5.00.

No free stickers will be issued. No sticker will be issued to any vehicle that has a Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW) of more than 10,000 lbs.

Any person that does not wish to purchase a Disposal Area sticker may pay a fee of \$15.00 at the Disposal Area gate for each trip, with a limit of five bags per trip. There shall be a fee of \$1.00 for each additional bag over the five bag maximum.

The Disposal Area sticker is good only for ones own personal household rubbish or garbage. Garbage and rubbish must be in tied bags or sealed boxes.

All stickers must be permanently affixed on the front, driver's side window. Misuse of a resident Disposal Area sticker shall consist of the following:

- a. The resident sticker registration number not matching the registration number of the vehicle that it is attached to;
- b. Sticker not permanently affixed to the front driver's side window;
- c. Sticker being altered, defaced, copied or made unreadable;
- d. Sticker being used to gain entry to the Disposal Area by persons other than to whom the sticker was issued; and,
- e. The giving of a resident sticker to another for unauthorized use.

Misuse of a sticker shall result in:

- a. \$30 fine for first offense
- b. \$200 fine for second offense

The Waste Management Superintendent or his designees, and Police Officers are authorized to issue said fines and to remove Disposal Area stickers for misuse.

SECTION II – DISPOSAL AREA REGULATIONS

All loads coming into the Disposal Area must be covered.

No Dump Picking.

Grass and leaves must be taken to the compost area and placed in the assigned area without bags or containers. Only compostable material will be deposited in the Compost Area; no material larger than 2" in diameter will be allowed. All bags and containers shall be disposed of in the appropriate area.

All waste must originate in the Town of Yarmouth; except for chargeable commercial debris.

All materials shall be placed in the designated disposal site.

Anyone tampering or damaging the Disposal Area gate or other Disposal Area property, or depositing of garbage in front of the gate, will be subject to prosecution.

All trees and large brush shall be disposed of in lengths not to exceed four feet (4') or shall be chipped.

All trucks weighing over 10,000lb g.v.w. must be lettered and numbered.

No one shall bring in any unmanaged hazardous wastes to the Disposal Area.

Waste oil shall be accepted at the designated tank. A maximum of two (2) gallons will be accepted from any person, per day.

Types of Oil: Engine, fuel, gear, cutting and hydraulic oils only.

Antifreeze shall be accepted at the designated tank.

SECTION III – DISPOSAL AREA FEES

Rubbish, builder's debris and demolition, unacceptable at the Transfer Station: \$140.00 per ton; mixed loads \$165.00 per ton, \$10.00 minimum. (After July 1, 2017 fee for C&D will be \$145.00 per ton: mixed loads will be \$170.00 approved by Board of Selectmen November 17, 2016)

Brush: \$65.00 per ton, \$5.00 minimum. No stumps shall be accepted.

Commercial Compost: \$35.00 per ton, \$10.00 minimum.

Scrap Metals & White Goods - \$65.00 per ton, \$10.00 minimum.

Garbage: \$170.00 per ton, \$15.00 minimum.

Use of Scales: \$5.00 per weighing.

Tire disposal charges: \$1.00 off the rim, \$3.00 on the rim.

Refrigerators, air conditioners, and dehumidifiers: \$18.00 per unit

Mattresses, Box Springs, Upholstered Furniture, and other large bulky items: \$15.00 each item

Woodchip Disposal: \$20.00 per ton, \$10.00 minimum. If there is anything mixed with the woodchips, a charge of \$65.00 per ton will apply.

CRTs (televisions, computer monitors, etc.) - \$15.00 per unit

WHOEVER, HIMSELF OR BY HIS AGENT OR SERVANT, OR AS A SERVANT OR AGENT OF ANY OTHER PERSON, OR ANY FIRM OR CORPORATION, VIOLATES THE ABOVE REGULATIONS SHALL BE PUNISHED BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00).
