AMENDMENT TO SHELLFISH REGULATIONS

RECREATIONAL USE

BAY SCALLOPS

EFFECTIVE DATE: Saturday, October 1, 2016 LEWIS BAY Sunrise to Sunset

NOTE: "CLOSED AREA ALL SHELLFISH" SIGNS DO NOT APPLY TO BAY SCALLOPS. MANY AREAS IN TOWN WILL CONTINUE TO BE CLOSED FOR QUAHOGS, OYSTERS, CLAMS AND MUSSELS, BUT WILL BE OPEN FOR SCALLOPS.

OPEN AREAS: LEWIS BAY – All Yarmouth waters in Lewis Bay include Uncle Robert Cove, and Mill Creek. This does not include areas marked as private shellfish grants.

CLOSED AREAS: Private Shellfish Grants as marked.

LIMIT: One (1) level Town approved legal limit bushel container per permit per week (Sunday through Saturday).

SIZE: Bay Scallops must have a well defined annual growth ring.

LANDING AREAS: Bay scallops may be checked in or landed at Englewood for Lewis Bay and larger boats may make prior arrangements with Shellfish Constable.

This amendment supersedes all other Recreational Bay Scallop regulation amendments.





BAY SCALLOPS

EFFECTIVE DATE: Saturday, October 1, 2016 NANTUCKET SOUND Sunrise to Sunset

NOTE: "CLOSED AREA ALL SHELLFISH" SIGNS DO NOT APPLY TO BAY SCALLOPS. MANY AREAS IN TOWN WILL CONTINUE TO BE CLOSED FOR QUAHOGS, OYSTERS, CLAMS AND MUSSELS, BUT WILL BE OPEN FOR SCALLOPS.

OPEN AREAS: NANTUCKET SOUND - All Yarmouth waters south of the mouth of Bass River and Lewis Bay generally known as Nantucket Sound.

CLOSED AREAS: Private Shellfish Grants as marked.

LIMIT: One (1) level Town approved legal limit bushel container per week (Sunday through Saturday).

SIZE: Bay Scallops must have a well defined annual growth ring.

LANDING AREAS: Bay scallops may be checked in or landed at Englewood or Bass River Beach for Nantucket Sound. Larger boats may make prior arrangements with Shellfish Constable.

This amendment supersedes all other Recreational Bay Scallop regulation amendments.



EFFECTIVE DATE: Tuesday, November 1, 2016 BASS RIVER Sunrise to Sunset

NOTE: "CLOSED AREA ALL SHELLFISH" SIGNS DO NOT APPLY TO BAY SCALLOPS. MANY AREAS IN TOWN WILL CONTINUE TO BE CLOSED FOR QUAHOGS, OYSTERS, CLAMS AND MUSSELS, BUT WILL BE OPEN FOR SCALLOPS.

OPEN AREAS: BASS RIVER - Georgetown Flats and Wilbur Park for hand rake and dip net only. Power dragging is allowed from the mouth of Bass River northerly to Follins Pond, EXCEPT Georgetown Flats and Wilbur Park. This area will be defined by marker buoys.

CLOSED AREA: Georgetown Flats and Wilbur Park for power dragging

LIMIT: One (1) level Town approved legal limit bushel container per week (Sunday through Saturday).

SIZE: Bay Scallops must have a well defined annual growth ring.

LANDING AREAS: Bay scallops may be checked in or landed at Aunt Julianne's dock / or checked in or landed at Bass River Beach.

This amendment supersedes all other Recreational Bay Scallop regulation amendments.
