

## AMENDMENT TO SHELLFISH REGULATIONS COMMERCIAL USE BAY SCALLOPS

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** Monday, October 5, 2020 LEWIS BAY Sunrise to Sunset  
Monday through Saturday - No Commercial Fishing on Sundays.

**NOTE:** "CLOSED AREA ALL SHELLFISH" SIGNS DO NOT APPLY TO BAY SCALLOPS. MANY AREAS IN TOWN WILL CONTINUE TO BE CLOSED FOR QUAHOGS, OYSTERS, CLAMS AND MUSSELS, BUT WILL BE OPEN FOR SCALLOPS.

**OPEN AREAS:** LEWIS BAY – All Yarmouth waters in Lewis Bay, include Uncle Roberts Cove, and Mill Creek. This does not include areas marked as private shellfish grants.

**CLOSED AREAS:** Private Shellfish Grants as marked.

**LIMIT:** Five (5) level Town approved legal limit bushel containers per day per permit holder. Two (2) permit holders per boat.

**SIZE:** Bay Scallops must have a well defined annual growth ring.

**LANDING AREAS:** Bay scallops may be checked in or landed at Englewood for Lewis Bay. Larger boats may make prior arrangements with Shellfish Constable.

**SPECIAL CONDITION:** When dragging for scallops, for safety purposes, one helper who possesses a State Bed Permit may assist a licensed Commercial Shellfisherman. Under this condition only one limit may be harvested.

This amendment supersedes all other Commercial Bay Scallop regulation amendments.

## AMENDMENT TO SHELLFISH REGULATIONS

### COMMERCIAL USE

### BAY SCALLOPS

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** Monday, October 5, 2020 NANTUCKET SOUND Sunrise to Sunset  
Monday through Saturday - No Commercial Fishing on Sundays.

**NOTE:** "CLOSED AREA ALL SHELLFISH" SIGNS DO NOT APPLY TO BAY SCALLOPS. MANY AREAS IN TOWN WILL CONTINUE TO BE CLOSED FOR QUAHOGS, OYSTERS, CLAMS AND MUSSELS, BUT WILL BE OPEN FOR SCALLOPS.

**OPEN AREAS:** NANTUCKET SOUND - All waters in Yarmouth

**LIMIT:** Five (5) level Town approved legal limit bushel containers per day per permit holder. Two (2) permit holders per boat.

**SIZE:** Bay Scallops must have a well defined annual growth ring.

**LANDING AREAS:** Bay scallops may be checked in or landed at Bass River Beach for Nantucket Sound. Larger boats may make prior arrangements with Shellfish Constable.

**SPECIAL CONDITION:** When dragging for scallops, for safety purposes, one helper who possesses a State Bed Permit may assist a licensed Commercial Shellfisherman. Under this condition only one limit may be harvested.

This amendment supersedes all other Commercial Bay Scallop regulation amendments.





## AMENDMENT TO SHELLFISH REGULATIONS COMMERCIAL USE BAY SCALLOPS

DATE: Monday, November 2, 2020 BASS RIVER Sunrise to Sunset  
Monday through Saturday - No Commercial Fishing on Sundays.

**NOTE: "CLOSED AREA ALL SHELLFISH" SIGNS DO NOT APPLY TO BAY SCALLOPS. MANY AREAS IN TOWN WILL CONTINUE TO BE CLOSED FOR QUAHOGS, OYSTERS, CLAMS AND MUSSELS, BUT WILL BE OPEN SCALLOPS.**

**OPEN AREAS: BASS RIVER** - Power dragging is allowed from the mouth of Bass River northerly to Follins Pond, EXCEPT Georgetown Flats and Wilbur Park in Yarmouth and, Grand Cove and the flat north of the entrance to Horsefoot Cove in Dennis. These areas will be defined by marker buoys.

**CLOSED AREAS:** Georgetown Flats and Wilbur Park in Yarmouth.

**LIMIT:** Five (5) level Town approved legal limit bushel containers per day per permit holder. Two (2) permit holders per boat. No more than two (2) drags per boat.

**SIZE:** Bay Scallops must have a well defined annual growth ring.

**LANDING AREAS:** Bay scallops may be checked in or landed at Bass River Beach.

**SPECIAL CONDITION:** When dragging for scallops, for safety purposes, one helper who possesses a State Bed Permit may assist a licensed Commercial Shellfisherman. Under this condition only one limit may be harvested.
