1. Discussion of Future Meeting Day/Time

The committee discussed the possibility of changing the day of the meeting, while keeping the meeting time of 4pm. It was ultimately decided to change the day of the meetings to the second Tuesday of the month going forward, with more meetings added as necessary.

2. CEDC Goal Discussion

The committee discussed their goals and reviewed potential changes and additions to them. Committee member Joanne Crowley suggested some wording and formatting changes that the committee agreed with. Steve O'Neil sent in his suggested edits ahead of the meeting, and members noted that they were good edits that should be incorporated. Some goals were merged where applicable and others were eliminated when it was clear that they could not be accomplished in the near future. Committee members agreed to have town staff consolidate their suggested changes for final review at a future meeting.

3. Committee Member Updates

Jack McCormack reported on the Blue Sky's Tower DRI that is currently being reviewed by the Cape Cod Commission. He reported that the public hearing was continued until July 12th at 5pm. Mary Vilbon reported that the Chamber of Commerce is working with a company to develop an app to promote the Town of Yarmouth's Conservation Trails titled, "Yarmouth Tour Guide".

4. Staff Updates

Kyle Pedicini, Economic Development Coordinator, reported that the Board of Selectmen expressed an interest in meeting with the CEDC in the near future to discuss Tourism Fund expenditures.

5. Minutes for Review
