

Old King's Highway Historic District

PAINTING

Criteria:

- Painting the exterior of your house (siding, trim, shutters, doors, etc.) requires approval when the color is changed
- Repainting the same color does not require approval
- Painting anything white does not require approval
- Changing from a color to white does not require approval
- The Old King's Highway Committee will review your color choice for appropriateness to the style and setting of the house
- A Certificate of Appropriateness is required to paint or change siding, trim, shutters, or doors to a color other than white
- Certificates of Appropriateness are reviewed at an Old King's Highway Committee hearing

Application Requirements:

- Certificate of Appropriateness application
- Four copies of the general specification sheet indicating the area(s) to be painted, including color chip(s)
- Four copies of color photos showing the front of the house and/or any other sides or items (doors, shutters, trim) to be painted
- \$25.00 application/filing fee
